FROM THE DESK OF SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

STUDENTS GET FUTURE-READY THIS SUMMER!



Last fall, the Cohoes City School District was awarded the Smart Transfer Early College in the High School grant. Cohoes was one of only two school districts in New York State to receive this grant, which supports selected students as they pursue a Regents diploma and 60 college credits before graduation, all at not cost to families. Cohoes has branded the Smart Transfer Grant as the Cohoes Future-Ready Pathways program. The four Future-Ready Pathways include: *Computers, Engineering and Technology, Health Sciences and Human Services, Early Childhood and Adolescent Education, and Business and Communications*. Students will choose a Pathway at the end of their sophomore year to prepare for further study (through HVCC and University at Albany) or employment in a related field.

Earlier this summer, 50 students in grades 9 and 10 took courses through Hudson Valley Community College. As part of becoming Future-Ready, students are matched with a career mentor and are supported in extended learning during the school year. This summer, students were thrilled to host Deputy Commissioner for Higher Education for the State Education Department, John D'Agati (pictured). Miriam Newell Biskin

We are sad to report the passing of our long time Chairwoman Miriam at 98 years of age. She graduated from Cohoes High School and NY State Teachers College at Albany. She held BA's in History and English. She taught and chaired the English Department at Cohoes High retiring after 37 years. Miriam was a prolific writer and authored many children's articles and two books. As an accomplished pianist, she loved entertaining her friends and neighbors. Irving was the love of her life and she nursed him through his illnesses including a massive stroke. Hopefully they are together again.

***"KEVENY TO BE RAZED ON WEDNESDAY"* That was the headline on Tuesday November 4, 2003 in the Troy Record .**

That news left many alma mater in the sad because their school finally was to become a parking lot.

Fond memories of a beloved school where so many spent four or more years will now be left with a souvenir brick and a lot of good remembrances.

Keveny was founded by the Reverend Thomas Keveny in 1860 as a parish school adjacent to St..Bernard's Church. In 1927, it moved to a new three story building on Ontario Street across from the church and was named Keveny Memorial Academy in honor of it's founder. It housed grades 1 through 12, but eventually became a high school. Cohoes Public School 8th graders also were schooled here for a short time in the fifties.

By the sixties, enrollment reached 600, in 1981 it dropped to 300 and bottomed out at 125 in the 86-87 school year. In June 1986, the Roman Catholic Diocese closed the school.

Neglect had caused the ceilings and roof to cave in and the exterior bricks were decaying.

This short history of Keveny Memorial Academy was taken from an account by the Troy Record provided by Ann McAteer Cavosie, a Keveny 1956 graduate.

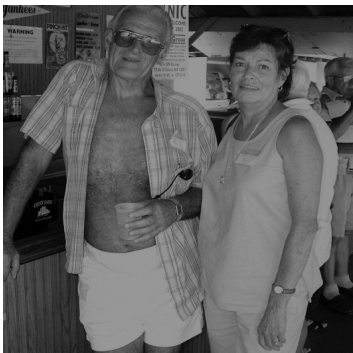
