Treasurer's Report...

First, I want to express our gratitude for your continued financial support of the Alumni Association. Since June 1, 2023, we have received a total of \$14,286 in payment of dues and donations At the Awards Ceremony on June 25, 2024, a grand total of \$84,612 was distributed to the seniors of the Class of '24. Of that grand total, \$53,300 came from the Alumni Association and its Awards sponsors.

Each year our goal is to meet all of our annual financial obligations solely from your dues and donations; those obligations include funding of the Founders' Awards and the publication and mailing of the newsletter and the postcard reminder in February. Both the newsletter and postcard are very successful in generating an influx of payments of dues and donations.

Anyone who would like more detailed information about our finances may obtain it at the annual general membership meeting that is held each year in May. We know that we can count on you to help us to reach our goal in 2025 through your continued and increased support!

A Profile of Marian Lambertson

In this issue of the newsletter, we have chosen to profile Marian Lambertson, an educator who made significant contributions to the students/alumni of CHS in areas beyond the curriculum and classroom. Her recent passing from us has spurred reflection on her accomplishments as a teacher of physical education. She was a driving force to innovate the standard curriculum to inspire students to view athletic activity as a life-long pursuit and as a means to better mental and physical health. She was also a major force to open competitive sports at the high school to include female athletes and teams. Every girl who has enjoyed physical ed. classes at CHS or has been part of a Tiger team owes a debt of gratitude to Mrs. Lambertson.

Marian Lambertsen (1933-2023)

Marian Lambertsen was another great gift to Cohoes High School as an educator, an athletic leader and innovator. A native of Waterford, Marian graduated from Waterford High School in 1950. In 1954, she graduated from Russell Sage College in Troy with her degree in physical education. Despite job offers from multiple districts, Marian chose to teach in Cohoes, first at Van Schaick Elementary School and then, in 1958, transferring to the High School. After 29 years of teaching, Marian retired in 1988.

Even in the early years of her career, when the physical education curriculum was dominated by calisthenics, Marian was innovative and incorporated sports like archery, tennis, and field hockey into the phys-ed curriculum in order to move toward physical activities that students would enjoy and that could become life-long interests for them. Marian advocated for and was successful in instituting intramural basketball, volleyball, tennis, and soccer in the phys-ed program, with a long-term goal of developing girls' teams in these sports; by 1964, she had instituted the intramural girls' bowling program which led to the formation of the team that succeeds at CHS today.

In 1967, CHS joined the Colonial Council, the newly-formed sports league for boys' sports teams in our area. Marian lobbied strongly for the recognition of women's teams in the Council as well. By 1969, her efforts were rewarded when CHS women's basketball, soccer, and volleyball were included in Colonial Council competition. In 1969, Marian became the first faculty advisor of the Girls' Athletic Association of CHS, the counterpart of the long-standing Varsity Club for boys' athletics. At various points in her career, Marian served as coach of the softball team, girls' varsity bowling team, girls' basketball team, girls' cheerleading squads and the girls' soccer team that won the first Colonial Council championship in 1976.

Throughout her teaching career, Marian continued to be an innovative educator who consistently strove to teach her students the value of health-conscious, enjoyable physical activity throughout their lifetimes. Her own personal example of commitment to sports and life-long physical fitness made her an excellent role model for others.

Awards Ceremony 2024...

On Tuesday, June 25, 2024 at 6 pm, Cohoes High School held its annual Awards/Honors Ceremony in its auditorium to honor and recognize the achievements of the Class of '24 in the presence of the graduates' families, friends, and guests. The program began with opening remarks by Superintendent Peggy O'Shea and Board of Education President Nadia Carey. Principal Laura LePage Tarlo introduced this year's valedictorian, Kyle Smith, salutatorian, Nyasia Wade, and honorable mention graduate, Luke Paradis. Honor medals and awards/scholarships were presented by Principal Tarlo, Assistant principal Heather Bradt, Athletic Director Jeffrey Huneau, members of the guidance staff, officers and sponsors of the Alumni Association, and special guests. The total amount of monies dispensed to seniors this year was \$84,612; of that amount, \$53,300 was made available by and through the Cohoes High School Alumni Association. These funds were awarded to 79 of the 111 members of the Class of 2024 in a record-setting total of 100 awards/scholarships.
